Literacy How has been piloting mCLASS Reading 3D as an alternative to the DRA2 (Developmental Reading Assessment). This automated, observational tool includes two assessments: DIBELS Next (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy) foundational skills assessment and the Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC), which collects a running record of students' reading behavior, including comprehension, with leveled text.
