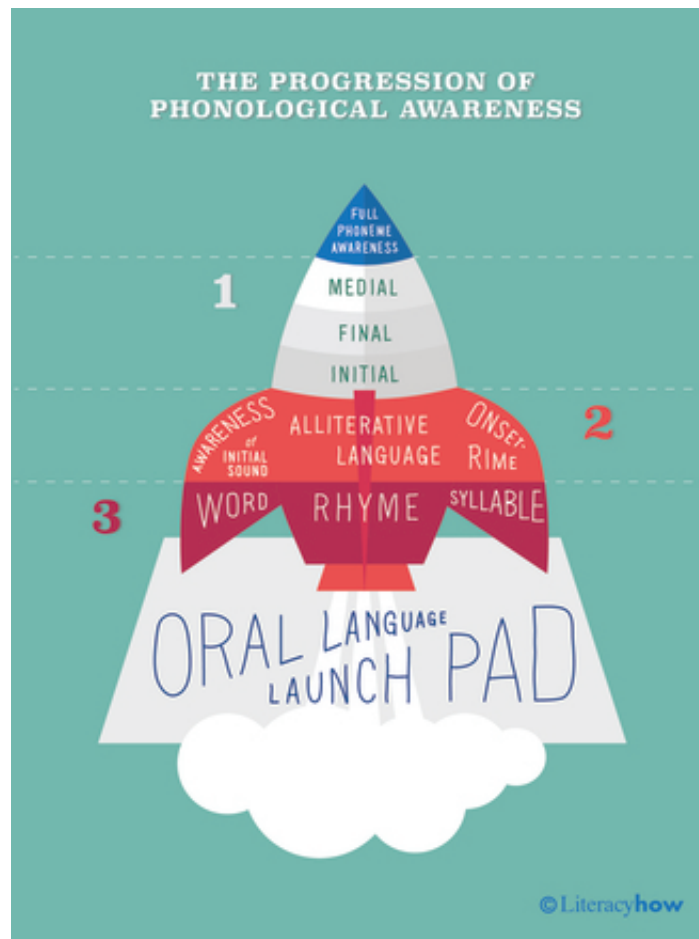


Literacy How-To: Fostering Phonological Awareness
